

#### **Drivers and Software**

FAX L Drivers		
Printer driver	You can print from an application using the machine by installing the printer driver on your computer. You can process print data at high speed by compressing the print data using the computer's processing capability.	
Fax driver	If you install the fax driver on your computer, you can select "Print" from an application, select the Canon fax driver as a printer, and specify the output destination and options. The fax driver converts the data into an image that conforms to standard fax protocols so that the data can be printed or saved using the recipient's fax machine.

# **Installing the FAX L Drivers**

Install the software to use the machine.




- If you are using a 64-bit operating system
  The FAX L drivers for 64-bit operating systems may not be supplied depending on your country or region.
- User rights for logging on to Windows Log on as a user with administrative rights.
- When installing via USB connection
   Connect the USB cable after the software installation.
   Make sure that the power of the machine is turned ON when connecting the USB cable.
- For Windows 2000 users


  User Software CD-ROM is not compatible with Windows 2000 and installation method is different. See "Installing the FAX L driver in Windows 2000" on p. 11.


#### **Installing with [Easy Installation]**

Insert the User Software CD-ROM into the slot on your computer.

## 5 Click [Next].




## 6 Click [Exit].





### **Installing with [Custom Installation]**

1 Insert the User Software CD-ROM into the slot on your computer.



**2** Click [Custom Installation].

#### **Windows XP**

- 1. From the [Start] menu, select [Run].
- 2. Enter "D:\MInst.exe", and then click [OK].

#### Windows Vista, 7

- 1. Enter "D:\MInst.exe" in [Start Search] or [Search programs and files] under the [Start] menu.
- 2. Press the [ENTER] key on the keyboard.
  - \* The CD-ROM drive name is indicated as "D:" in this manual. The CD-ROM drive name may differ depending on the computer you are using.
- [] If the language selection screen is displayed before the CD-ROM setup screen appears:

Select the language and then click [Next].

# 3 Select the check box next to the application you want to install, and then click [Install].



- X The options to be displayed differ depending on your country or region.
- XTo install the e-Manual, select the [Manuals] check box.
  - \* If [Manuals] does not appear, install the e-Manual from the Multi-lingual User Manual CD supplied with the machine.




7 If you selected Manuals in step 3, installation of the manuals starts.

Next, installation of Product Extended Survey Program starts.



### **Installing the FAX L driver in Windows 2000**

- 1 Insert the User Software CD-ROM into the slot on your computer.
- 2 Click [My computer], right-click the CD-ROM icon, and then select [Open] from the pop-up menu.
- **3** Open [DRIVERS] -> [XXXXXX]\* -> [32bit], and then double-click [Setup.exe].


  \* Select your language for [XXXXXX].
- 4 Click [Next].
- 5 Click [Exit].

#### **USB** cable connection


## 1 Remove the cap (A) on the USB port of the machine.

Remove the cap by pulling out the string.



#### **2** Connect the USB cable.

- Flat end (A): Connect to the USB port on the computer.
- Square end (B): Connect to the USB port on the machine.



#### If a dialog box is displayed:

Follow the onscreen instructions and complete installation.

When installation is complete, check the installation results. See "Checking the installation results" on p. 13.

## **Checking the installation results**

Check that the FAX L drivers are installed correctly.

Check if the following icons are displayed for the installed applications.




#### **About Icons that Are Displayed:**

Icons for each driver may be displayed separately or only representative icon may be displayed depending on the operating system.

In the Online Help, all the functions of the driver software and information about options are included. If you want to know descriptions of the functions and settings immediately when using the driver software, make use of the Online Help.




# **Appendix**

#### How to Check the Windows Vista/7 Processor Version

- 1 Select [Control Panel] from the [Start] menu.
- 2 Display [System].
  - Windows Vista/Windows 7

    Click [System and Maintenance] or [System and Security] → [System].
- **3** Check the processor version.
  - For 32-bit version [32-bit Operating System] is displayed.
  - For 64-bit version [64-bit Operating System] is displayed.



## **Uninstalling the Software**

If you do not need the printer driver, fax driver, or Product Extended Survey Program, you can uninstall them with the following procedure.


#### IMPORTANT

Confirm the following before uninstalling the software:

- You must be have administrative privileges on the computer.
- You should have the installation software (in case you want to re-install the drivers).
- You have closed all applications on your computer.

#### To uninstall the printer/fax driver

- 1 From the [Start] menu, click [(All) Programs] -> [Canon] -> [FAX L100 L150 L170] -> [Uninstall Drivers].
- 2 Click [Delete].



3 Click [Yes] to confirm the uninstallation.



4 Click [Exit] (or [Restart]).



#### To uninstall the Product Extended Survey Program

Open [Programs and Features].

#### **Windows XP**

From the [Start] menu, select [Control Panel], and then double-click [Add or Remove Programs].

#### Windows Vista/7

- 1. From the [Start] menu, select [Control Panel].
- 2. Click [Uninstall a program] or double-click [Programs and Features].
- 2 Select [Canon Laser Printer/Scanner/Fax Extended Survey Program], and then click [Uninstall].
- **3** Follow the on-screen instructions.
